**FLOURISHING FUTURES**

All children in **Reception, Year 1, and Year 2** receive free school meals automatically. However, if you think you may be eligible for additional support, we strongly encourage you to register. Doing so allows the school to access **additional funding of up to £1,480 per child** each year.

You may be eligible if you receive any of the following:

- Universal Credit (after receiving your first payment)
- Child Tax Credit
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Income Support
- The 'guaranteed element' of Pension Credit
- Working Tax Credit or the Working Tax Credit run-on
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999

*Note: Eligible families may also receive additional support during school holidays through Local Authority schemes.*

**First Day of School: Friday 4th September**

From September, your child will be able to attend school full-time. To support a smooth transition, we will keep the gates open a little longer until 11th September .

**Reception gate opening times:**

① 8:40 AM – 8.50 AM

This allows quieter and calmer entry for children who may need more time. If you have any concerns, please speak with your child's class teacher during your face-to-face meeting.
