We are writing to inform you about important updates to our Relationships and Health Education Curriculum. This curriculum was made statutory by The Department for Education in 2020, and they have published updated guidance to take effect this September 2026.

At All Saints Marsh Academy, we remain committed to delivering RHE that is inclusive, accessible, and developmentally appropriate for every learner. As a Trust family of schools, we have been working to develop and refine our RHE curriculum and policy. Our updated policy reflects our continued focus on safeguarding, emotional wellbeing, and preparation for adulthood.

Key features of our RSE provision include:

- Differentiated content: Tailored to pupils' cognitive, social, and communication needs
- Inclusive teaching approaches: Use of visual supports, social stories, and sensory resources
- Core themes: Relationships, boundaries, consent, and online safety
- Sensitive delivery of complex topics: Including puberty, taught in ways appropriate to pupils' levels of understanding
- Updates to non-statutory Sex Education: including enhanced teaching on healthy relationships, personal safety, body changes, and family diversity. Schools will be in touch separately with full details about the Year 6 lessons and how these changes will be introduced.

### Parental Consultation

We value the vital role parents and carers play in supporting children's learning. As part of the policy update process, we will be holding a period of parental consultations during the summer term. This will include:
