(man-made) Geography. Our big question in this unit is, "How does the physical Geography of South America impact the people who live there?" We begin every unit with making links back to previous units and I was impressed by how well Templar could use their previous physical Geography learning to make informed predictions about settlements in South America. For example, they predicted that there would be more dispersed settlements in the mountainous regions because it is difficult to grow crops, rear cattle, build and access water or coastal trade from these locations. What a great start to the unit!




